#### Hello friends!

Every day, our mail carrier drops a stack of letters through our door. Each letter contains a handwritten request from an incarcerated person: "I'm interested in fantasy and off-grid living." "Would you send me any gay-bisexual and transgender novels you may have? There are several of us who are ravenous readers and share all our books." "I'm writing to request puzzle books please."

Over the course of a month, these daily stacks total about 500 letters. Three times a week, our volunteers gather to carefully read each letter, comb through our library of donated books to find the perfect match, and then pack the books up along with a personalized note of goodwill.

We're reminded of the value of this work every time we receive a thank you letter. As one person formerly incarcerated in New Jersey wrote this year, "Your program made life 'on the inside' just a little better, for which I thank you immensely. I hope you continue to share this gift with other inmates, as it truly makes a difference!"

So far this year we've received over 5,000 requests, and by the time 2023 closes another 1,000 letters will have passed through our hands. Your generosity makes this work possible – thank you! Our donors keep the lights on over our library of donated books and cover postage to send books over prison walls. 
